1	Chateau Lauriol 2003 Dark, ruby colour, powerful aroma of wild blackcurrants backed by an incredible soft palate - inky and rich - excellent claret.	25
2	Chateau des Roques, Puyseguin, St Emilion 2004 This is super dark fruited St Emilion with lovely soft, dry tannins. The 04 vintage shows lovely plummy fruit with hints of truffle and has a ripe, black berry fruited finish.	26
3	Segla (2 nd Wine of Chateau Rauzan Segla) Margaux 2002 The second wine of the outstanding Rauzan Segla, one of Margaux's finest. A fine vintage - the wine is full bodied & robust with soft tannins and rich blackcurrant fruit.	48
4	Chateau de Pez Saint Estephe, Cru Bourgeois 2004 Solid, substantial and concentrated in the mouth, the wine contains a spicy hint of tannin which blends smoothly into the wine.	59

5	Pinot Noir, Adamas 2006 This wine has a very accessible nature to it. Soft red fruits are backed up on the palate with gentle spice and structure.	32
6	Fleurie Joseph Drouhin 2005/2007 The true style of the Gamay grape - soft summer fruit flavours and juicy finish.	33
7	Chorey Les Beaune, Joseph Drouhin 2006 Dark red with a good structure. Rich, elegant and well balanced with a very fine finish picking up flavours of liquorice. Perfect with red meat and game	45

8	Gigondas Parcelles 38, Vignobles Jerome Quiot, 2005 A blend of Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre and Cinsault. The wine undergoes maturation in large oak foudres and smaller barrels. Deep coloured with bramble fruit and herbs dominating on the nose. The palate is full-bodied and concentrated with a hint of chocolate and firm tannins. An outstanding wine.	43
9	Chateauneuf du Pape, Vignobles Jerome Quiot 2006 Produced by the proprietors of Chateau de Trignon this is first rate Chateauneuf. Mostly Grenache with some Syrah in the blend and aged for 6 months in oak. The resulting wine is soft full bodied and opulent with hints of spice and black cherry.	49

10	Nero d'Avola Shiraz Il Paradosso Sicily 2007 Dark garnet in colour with hints of leather, tar and berry fruit. Overall, this is soft and velvety and complements lamb perfectly.	16
11	Chianti La Vignia, Tuscany 2007 A lovely, simple style of Chianti that really shows off the primary fruit flavours of the Sangiovese grape. Lots of red cherry fruit backed up by a gentle structure.	20

12	Tempranillo Tinto Quintana Bodegas Victorianas 2005 This would put many Riojas to shame. Soft, chocolatey Tempranillo fruit rounded out and spiced up by a year in oak barrels. Mellow and medium weight.	16
13	Rioja Reserve Bodegas Campillo, Rioja Alavesa 2002 Deep, complex aromas with very developed hint of fruit, leather and vanilla. On the palate, it is powerful and full-bodied with a well-balanced tannic flavour on the finish.	34
14	Gran Reserve Rioja, Bodegas Campillo 1995 The pinnacle of Rioja production, beautiful mellow wine with well integrated oak flavours and a very long smooth finish.	50

15	Merlot Red Earth, Southern Australia 2004 Vibrant rich crimson with strawberry, mulberry and blackberry fruit with a touch of spicy oak. Soft and sassy.	18
16	Shiraz Ceravolo Estate Adelaide Plains (Double Gold) 2004 Rich colours and full fruit character - ripe mulberries, blackberry, strawberry, black cherry, blueberry with a hint of chocolate and oriental spice.	24
17	Johann's Garden Henschke 2004 A blend of Grenache, Shiraz and Mourvèdre. Sweet ripe intense spicy rhubarb, plums, anise herbs and mace aromas. Beautiful lush ripe blackberry and mulberry hints on the palate form a central core of fruit; delicious sweet mature velvety tannins and a long finish.	43
18	Epsilon "Coal Sack" Shiraz Barossa Valley 2006 "Full-throttle Shiraz" (91 points) Robert Parker Jr	40

19	Zinnia Zinfandel Russian River Valley 2005 A wonderful brooding, deep dark purple colour, an explosive aroma of wild blackberries and cherries complimented by a soft, velvety, distinguished sensation.	30
20	Pinot Noir Rodney Strong Russian River, Sonoma 2006 Soft and rich, with layers of intense cherry, cola, caramel and earth, this impressive, full-bodied wine is aged in 100% French oak, which adds a distinctive vanilla character.	43

21	Cabernet Sauvignon Santa Ema Maipo Valley 2007 Ruby red with garnet hues. Aromas of deep red fruits. Excellent harmonious medium bodied red. Beautifully rich wine!	18
22	Carmenere Barrel Select Santa Ema Maipo Valley 2005 This is an indigenous grape and shows the same structure and characteristics as cabernet sauvignon but with softer merlot-like plumminess.	19
23	Merlot Reserve Santa Ema Maipo Valley 2005 Mature blackberry and blueberry flavours together with sweet, toasty notes. A perfect union of fruit and wood, it is an elegant and structured wine with a good finish.	22

25	<u>Pinot Noir Francesca Bay, Marlborough 2007</u> A vibrant cherry red colour and aromas of wild strawberries, rich and velvety with sweet ripe red berry fruits bursting out - a truly elegant but rich Pinot Noir, a lovely wine.	25
	<u>South Africa</u>	
26	<u>Shiraz The Veldt Range Robertson Valley 2006</u> A soft and voluptuous Shiraz displaying ripples of spice and black pepper. A subtle nuance of oak gives additional body and structure to this eminently drinkable wine.	16
27	<u>Pinotage Terroir Selection, Walker Bay, Springfontein 2006</u> The wine's colour is centred in a deep inky heart with a youthful purple rim. Elegant ripe grape tannins form the backbone of the wine around which red cherry, spices, hints of mulberry and cassis linger on the palate. This wine is best enjoyed with stews and all lamb dishes.	25

28	<u>Rosé Syrah Cuvee Valonnee Vin de Pays d'Oc, France 2006</u> A brilliant pink colour, with a soft red fruit fragrance on the nose, backed up by a gentle but evident structure on the palate.	16
29	<u>White Zinfandel Roundhill Vineyards Sonoma, California 2007</u> Aromas of watermelon, kiwi and freshly picked strawberries coupled with sweet citrus of a mandarin orange and cranberry fruitiness. Perfect on a warm summer day.	19
30	<u>Bodegas Campillo Rose, Spain, Rioja Alavesa 2007</u> An extra fruity and aromatic rosé redolent of raspberry, strawberry and peaches.	21

31	Petit Chablis Domaine De Colombier 2007 Classic Petit Chablis. The nose is loaded with minerals, citrus, white flower aromas with hints of wet stone. Minerally, tight and racy with cool flavours and perfect balance.	27
32	Chablis 1er Cru Vaillons Louis Michel et Fils 2005/2006 Wonderful abundance of fruit, soft, rich and powerful with the tell tale minerally overtone. Elegant and refined it will improve over the next five years to become a stunning wine.	54

33	Muscadet de Sevre et Maine, Clos de la Fontaine, Sur Lie Vieilles Vignes 2007 Classic Muscadet, bottled on the 'lees' for extra freshness and flavour. Crisp, dry and with long lasting flavour.	19
34	Pouilly Fumé Patrice Moreux 2007 Wonderful concentration of fresh gooseberry and cut grass aromas with classic smokey, apple tart nose, nice full palate with good balance. A super food wine.	29
35	Sancerre Blanc, Domaine Hubert Brochard Chavignol 2007 This is soft yellow green in colour with crisp acidity and offers grapefruit, lime, spice and mineral notes. Over all this is beautifully balanced with good length.	33

36	Fleur d'Alsace Hugel et Fils, Riquewihr 2006 A fantastic wine, dry and fresh with wonderful floral aromas and flavours. This classic wine allies the suave spicy flavour of Gewurztraminer, the body of Pinot Gris, the finesse of Riesling and the grapiness of Muscat.	23

37	Oppenheimer Krötenbrunnen 2006 Medium wine from the banks of the Rhine, ideal on its own or with chicken and fish dishes.	17

41	<u>Gewürztraminer/Verdelho Opal Ridge, Benton Vineyards 2008</u> A medium wine with a lovely fresh, floral character balanced by crisp acidity on the finish. Very fruity style, clean and crisp with flavours of Guava and fruit salad.	19
42	<u>Unoaked Chardonnay Red Earth, Southern Australia 2007</u> Left unwooded to highlight its own natural zesty citrus peach and ripe melon flavours. On the finish fresh and crisp. Citron hues in the colouring and honeysuckle notes on the nose.	18
43	<u>Sauvignon Blanc Ceravolo Estate Adelaide Plains, Southern Australia 2007</u> Vibrant fresh style - leafy and herbaceous aromas with a zesty palate of limes, lychees & green apples, it enhances lightly spiced foods, seafoods and salads or ideal as an aperitif.	22
